★ Green Tea Picking & Shimada Rose Hill Garden Park | Sat, May 2

Enjoy tea picking at Greenpia Makinohara Tea Farm in Shizuoka Prefecture. Lastly, we will visit Shimada Rose Hill Park, a prominent 1.9-hectare floral garden with approximately 9,000 rose bushes consisting of 500 varieties from around the world.

Mitsumine Shrine & Musashi Kyuryo National Forest Park | Sun, May 3

Mitsumine Shrine is nestled in a forested area at the summit of Mt. Mitsumine in Chichibu that is colorfully and ornately decorated. Afterwards we will go to Musashi Kyuryo National Park, located on Hiki Hills in Namegawa, Saitama Prefecture. It is also recognized as a national forest park. In 1974, it opened as the first national park. *Admission fees are included.*
