

If you board two pets at once, the second pet gets a 20% discount. All dogs must have current rabies, distemper/parvo and Bordetella shots. Cats need rab and distemper/parvo. Proof of vaccinations will be required before any animal can be boarded at the facility. Any animals exhibiting vomiting, diarrhea, coughing, sneezing or runny eyes at the time of kennel entry won't be accepted and will be referred to a veterinarian. Except for incoming rabies quarantines, animals less than four months old,
