DIFFICULTY LEVEL*: INTERMEDIATE (5-Mile/8-km)

On this 4-to-5-hour hike you can enjoy scenic views of Tokyo and surrounding areas. There are a variety of dining options and culturally rich temples as well.

***Intermediate:** Trails are 50% uphill and downhill, and 50% flat, with a variety of terrain. Ascending these trails are moderately physically demanding and descending them is moderately demanding on lower body muscles and joints. Total distance is 6 to 10 miles.



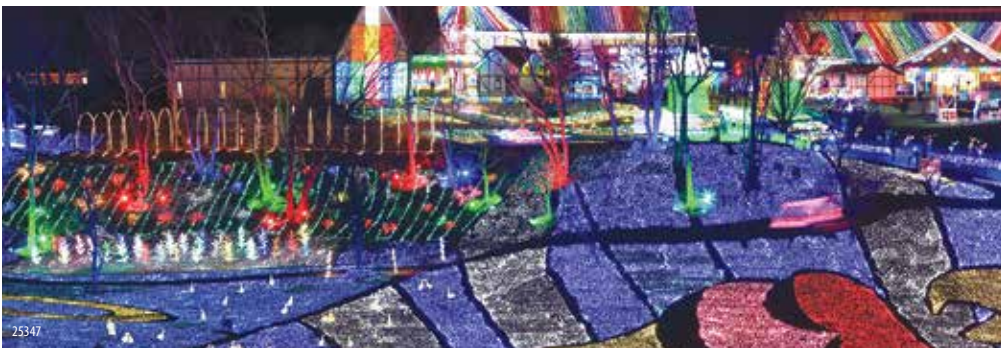
Hakone Glass Blowing, Owakudani & Lake Ashi Cruise | Sun, Dec 7

Enjoy glass blowing and various activities at Hakone Gora Park, then visit Owakudani for lunch. Finally, we will take a cruise on Lake Ashi and see Mt. Fuji and the Torii Gate of Hakone Shrine.

For the glass blowing craft shop, the minimum age for this is 6 years (not included in the price for ages 0-5). It will take one week to ship the glass you create.

★Orange Picking, Sunosaki Shrine & Daifukuji Temple | Sat, Dec 20

Ages & Cost: (4 & up) \$40 / (0-3) \$35 | (E1-E5): \$32

Reward Points: 250 | Depart: 0630 / Return: 2000

We will visit Chikura Orange Center for 60 minutes where you may pick and eat as many oranges as you like. Packed oranges are available for purchase. Next, is Sunosaki Shrine. This is a scenic spot where you can see Mt. Fuji from its torii gate. Finally, visit Daifukuji Temple. According to legend, in 717 during the Yoro era, the monk Gyoki (668-749) received divine inspiration during his pilgrimage to the eastern provinces. He carved the Eleven-Headed Kannon Bodhisattva into the natural rock face to pray for maritime safety and abundant catches for local fishermen.

This walk could be arduous for those with knee problems. Admission fees are included.

Experience an exhilarating and physically challenging zip line course that will push your climbing and balance skills to the limit. Participants are equipped with a harness and attached to safety line as they zip from tree to tree. There is a 15-minute safety brief.
