Ochudo trail is a trail that circles Mt. Fuji halfway at the 5th Station level (about 2,300 meters / 7,546 feet). You can see not only the dynamic Mt. Fuji that dominates the view in front of you, but also lakes, and range of peaks of the Southern Alps. This is mainly a flat hike with little ascending and descending. Sightseeing includes: Komitake Shrine and Oshino Village.

Due to the high altitude of this hike, recommended minimum age is 6 years.
