Sat, Sep 3 **DIFFICULTY LEVEL: ADVANCED**

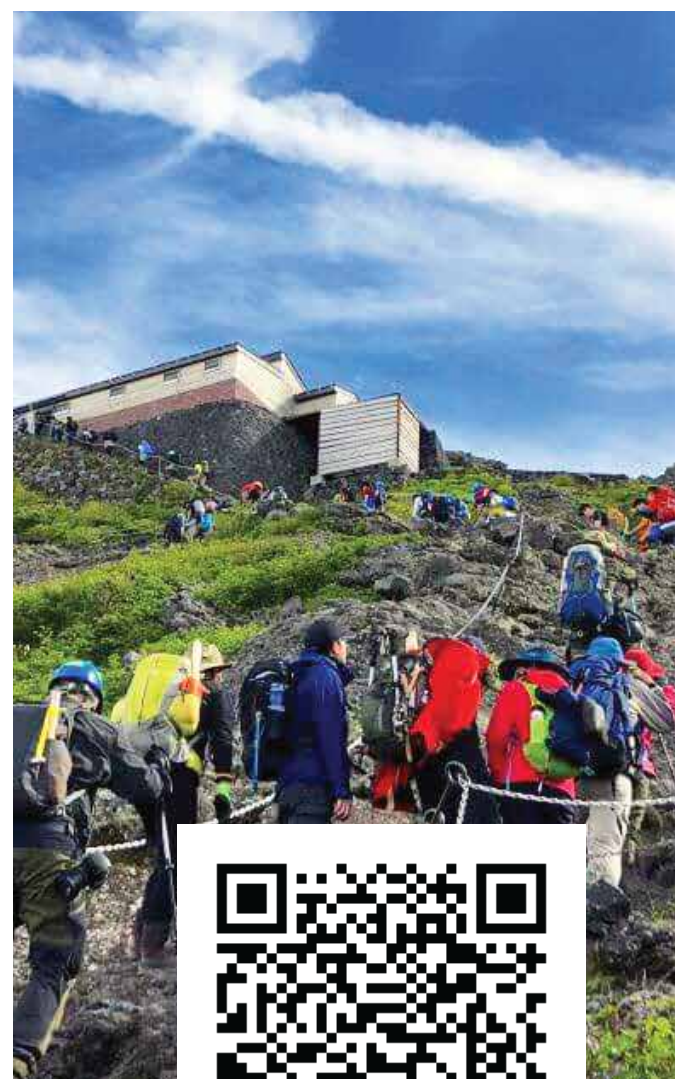

Depart Atsugi: 4 a.m. | Return: 10 p.m. | Depart Mt. Fuji: 7 p.m.  
Mt. Fuji is 3770 meters / 12,389 feet high and will test your ability to climb in high altitudes to the limit. You'll start at Fuji Subaru Line 5th station. Price includes bus transportation, tour guide service, Mt. Fuji Climber Coin & T-shirt. Due to high altitudes and arduous trail conditions this tour is restricted to those 6 years and older. In case of inclement weather, tour will be cancelled.

Sun, Sep 4 **DIFFICULTY LEVEL: EASY / BEGINNER**

Ochudo trail is a trail that circles Mt. Fuji halfway at the 5th Station level (about 2,300 meters / 7,546 feet). You can see not only the dynamic Mt. Fuji that dominates the view in front of you, but also lakes, and a range of peaks of the Southern Alps. This is mainly a flat hike with very little ascending and descending. Sightseeing include: Komitake Shrine and Oshino Village.

**Note:** Bring water. Due to the high altitude of this hike, recommended minimum age is 6 years.

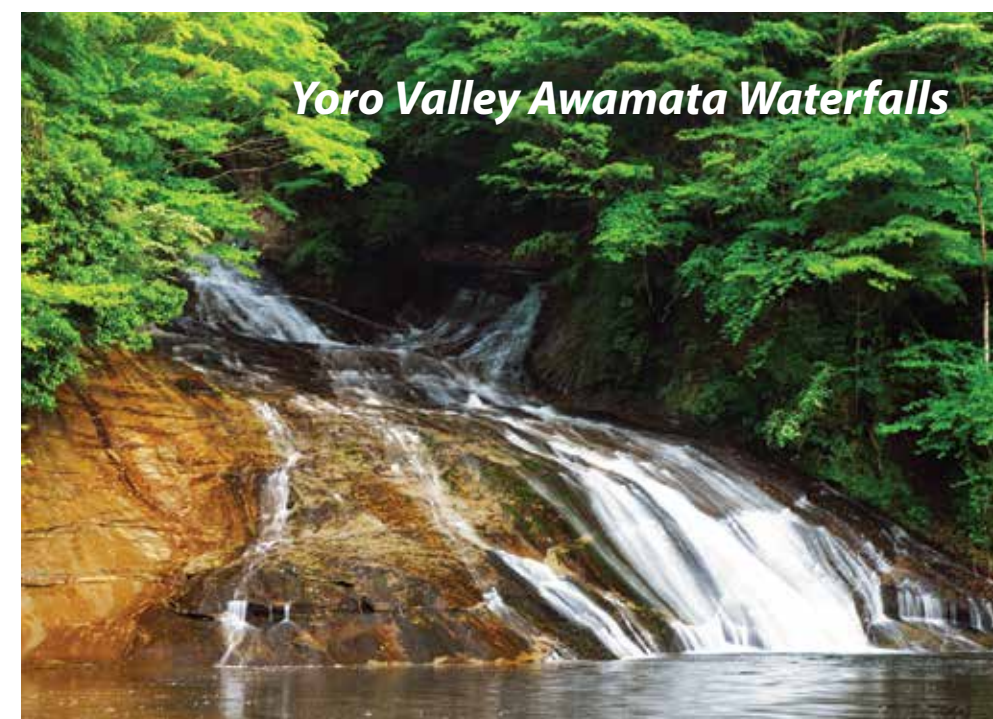

### NAF Atsugi MWR ITT Hiking Classification:

- **EASY / BEGINNER:** Trails are 80% flat and 20% ascending and descending. Total distance-about 6 miles.
- **INTERMEDIATE:** Trails are 50% uphill and downhill, and 50% flat, with a variety of terrain. Ascending these trails are moderately physically demanding and descending them is moderately demanding on lower body muscles and joints. Total distance is 6 to 10 miles.
- **ADVANCED:** Trails are 90% up and down hill with rugged and slippery terrain, with a total distance of 6 to 10 miles. Mt. Fuji falls in this category due to its high elevation.
