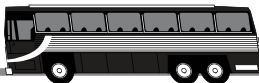

Senjojiki Cirque & Suwa Taisha Shrine

Embark on a breathtaking journey to the Senjojiki Cirque, a majestic amphitheater carved by ancient glaciers that exemplifies the grandeur of Nagano's Central Alps. The Komagatake Ropeway on the eastern side of the range whisks you up 2,600 meters, dropping you off at the cirque's doorstep. Here, we will go on a 45–60 minute trek and enjoy the alpine scenery surrounded by towering peaks. Afterwards, we will visit Suwa Taisha Shrine, historically known as Suwa Daimyōjin, which is a group of revered Shinto shrines. Admissions to scheduled places are included. Bring extra Yen and rain gear. Wear comfortable shoes.

After enjoying lunch near Togendai Port, we'll embark on a scenic cruise across Lake Ashi to take in magnificent views of Mt. Fuji and the Torii Gate of Hakone Shrine. Minimum age for this tour is 6 years due to the glass blowing craft shop requirements. Glass blowing is not included in the price for ages 0-5. Bring extra Yen and warm jacket. Wear comfortable shoes.

Experience the electric atmosphere of one of the Kanto Plain's largest events: the Kawagoe Night Festival. In the town nicknamed 'Little Edo,' you can catch a glimpse of what life was like when the Tokugawa Shogun ruled the land. On display are merchants' homes constructed in the Kura-zukuri style, The Old Bell Tower, and 500 statues of Rakan. This festive two-day event features parades and music, originating in 1648 with a procession of portable shrines that evolved into its present-day incarnation of giant floats with life-sized dolls, designated as national cultural importance. Bring extra Yen or lunch, souvenirs, comfortable shoes, a flashlight, and a small portable folding stool.

Hiryu & Chisuji Waterfalls Hike

Difficulty: Advanced

Trails are 90% up and downhill with rugged and slippery terrain, with a total distance of 6 to 10 miles. Mt. Fuji falls into this category due to its high elevation.



Challenge yourself with an advanced 4-hour hike to the stunning Hiryu and Chisuji Waterfalls. This rugged, slippery trail rewards hikers with incredible views of cascading water and vibrant fall colors. Due to the trail conditions, the minimum age for this hike is 6 years. Bring extra Yen, a packed lunch, and water. Wear comfortable hiking shoes.
