Make a house-shaped stained-glass Christmas gift or make something else for your home. Next, enjoy an unforgettable cruise around Dogashima Cave. *Due to Glass Craft Shop rules, the minimum age for this craft is 9 years. If the cruise is canceled due to inclement weather, it will be changed to Toi Gold Mine. Admission fees to scheduled places are included.*



★Inubosaki Lighthouse, Byoubugaura Cliffs & Tokyo Bay Lalaport | Sun, Nov 2

Ages & Cost: (12 & up) \$35 / (0-11) \$30 | **(E1-E5): \$28** | **Reward Points:** 350 | **Depart:** 0600 / **Return:** 1930

For a magnificent view of the ocean we will visit Inubosaki Lighthouse. Within this lighthouse is a corkscrew staircase with 99 steps. *(This could be arduous for those with knee problems.)* Next, we will visit to Byougaura Cliffs. The sheer cliffs, which look as if they were carved out of the ground, are said to be likened to the "White Walls" of Dover on the English Channel, and are also known as the "Dover of the East." Lastly, LaLaport Tokyo Bay is a mall-style shopping center located in Funabashi City, Chiba Prefecture. It is the first LaLaport and is positioned as a flagship. With approximately 440 stores, it is the largest in Japan, attracting approximately 25 million visitors annually. *Admission fees to scheduled places are included.*



Hiryu & Chisui Waterfalls Hike | Sat, Nov 8

SIGN UP IS IN-PERSON ONLY | DIFFICULTY LEVEL: ADVANCE*

Ages & Cost: (6 & up) \$40 | **(E1-E5): \$32** | **Reward Points:** 100 | **Depart:** 0630 / **Return:** 1530

This is an advanced-level 4-hour hike where you can take in views of numerous waterfalls and fall colors. *Due to the slippery rugged trail, the minimum age for this hike is 6 years. Bring water and wear comfortable hiking shoes.*

***ADVANCED:** Trails are 90% up and down hill with rugged and slippery terrain, with a total distance of 6 to 10 miles. Mt. Fuji falls in this category due to its high elevation.

Nagatoro River Cruise & Ashikaga Flower Park Illumination | Sat, Nov 15

The KABA BUS is both a bus and a boat, named after the hippopotamus, the king of amphibious animals. *Admission fees to scheduled places are included.*

Walk along the coast for about 50 minutes. Lastly, enjoy the Granpal Illumination Park. *Admission fees to scheduled places are included.*

Firstly, we will ride a cable car to Panorama Park. Izu Panorama Park is a lodging facility consisting of a mountaintop area with a terrace offering a spectacular view at the peak of Mt. Katsuragi. Next, we will visit Shuzenji Temple and a small bamboo forest. *Admission fees are included.*
