Cancellation Policy

- Tour must be cancelled 7 business days prior to the date of the trip to avoid penalty.
- 100% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled the same day the trip.
- 70% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled the day before the trip.
- 50% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled 2 days before the trip.
- 30% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled 3 days before the trip.
- 20% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled 4-6 days before the trip.

Understanding the Port Guide

- 1. Listed price for each trip can accommodate up to 43 passengers on all trips, except DMZ Trip. DMZ Trip is set to accommodate up to 40 passengers, regardless of the amount of actual sign-ups. No partial payment adjustments allowed for less than max number of passengers.
- 2. Payment will be made to **Navy MWR Korea**. MWR pays everything upfront to the tour company. Ship must provide tour dates, number of buses needed and number of passengers for each tour 5-7 days prior to arrival, for reservation of buses/ tour guides.
- 3. If a check is returned for any reason, an administrative fee will be added to the invoice.
- 4. Prices are subject to change by vendor with little or no prior notice.
- 5. Navy MWR Korea, or any other federal agency, is not responsible for any errors nor do these constitute federal endorsement. Information is only provided to serve as a guide.
- 6. Every effort is made by MWR to find the best service from the vendors; however, quality of service cannot be guaranteed.

3. Gyeonju (Kyongju) Cultural Tour

4. DMZ Tours (based on availability)

Korea is the only divided country in the world with borders of each side within an arms distance. After the Korean War (June 25, 1950- July 27, 1953), South Korea and North Korea negotiated and designated the DMZ [demilitarized zone] 2km away from the truce line on each side of the border. As one of the last relics of the Cold War, the DMZ attracts a great deal of public interest. Korea DMZ tourist sites have been created for this unique area where tension and peace coincide.

Cost

Bus: Daily cost of \$1,520

No English translator/Guide (DMZ provides English speaking tour)

Max Passengers: 40 people

<u>Itinerary</u> - Travel Time: ~6 hours one way

Bus departure & return based on request. (Estimate 16 hours)

Not Available on Mondays

<u>Notes</u>

Bring Korean Won for meals, snacks and souvenirs.

Trips requested at least 3 weeks prior have the best chance of obtaining slots. All names and information for each PAX are required at least 7 days prior to tour. For more wide availability, please see the next slide for a trip to visit the DMZ without the JSA.

Cost

Bus: Daily cost of \$405

English translator/guide: No translator or guide is needed.



8. Chinhae Trip

COMFLEACT Chinhae (CFAC) is about a 15 min trip from Chinhae ROK pier or 1.5 hours from Busan ROK pier. CFAC has a Mini-mart (BX), Commissary, Community Bank, and MWR Facilities to include two restaurants, a bar, fitness center, coin laundromat, recreation center, and more).

<u>Cost</u>

Bus: Daily cost of \$335

English translator/guide: No translator or guide is needed for this trip.

Depart the pier at 0900 and return around 1800.

* This tour price also applies for sporting event transportation to Chinhae.



9. Wi-Fi

Connect with family or download your favorite shows with Korea's 5G Wi-Fi. Speak with an MWR Representative about the following options.

Rates:

In Korea a day is based on actual day, not 24-hour period. Ex: If you pick up at 11:59pm and turn it in at 12:01am = 2-days.

Pier side vendor individual rentals (pucks and SIM card)

- SIM Card: \$6.00 (1-day), \$15 (3-days), \$23 (5-days)
- Wi-Fi Puck (connect up to 3 devices): \$4.00 (1-day)
 - \$100 Wi-Fi puck deposit is automatically charged with payment.

Group Pick-up & Return Service (pucks only)

- Wi-Fi Puck (connect up to 3 devices): \$4.50 (1-day) per device
 - No deposit hold; however POC will be charged \$100.00 for each
 - Wi-Fi Puck not returned.

11. Port Brief Information

• Wi-Fi

- Available almost everywhere in Korea (even liberty buses, city buses, and metro.
- The base you pull into is not a U.S. Base, it is a ROK Base and has strict security protocol. No Wi-Fi is available on base and please do not FaceTime or take photos of the pier layout or the base. Security will come and take your phone.

Taxi

- Taxi's are very cheap in Korea.
- 99% of taxi's take credit card.
- Uber doesn't exist in Korea. Download "Kakao T" to call taxi's and pay the driver when you arrive at destination.
- Taxi's are not allowed on base and we HIGHLY recommend not calling a taxi from the front gate due to exposure to protesters. Please take the liberty buses in and out the front gate.

Navigation

• Google Maps doesn't exist in Korea. Download "Naver Maps" for directions to anywhere you want to go.

ATM on Base

- There is one Community Bank ATM located on the ROK Base. It is inside of a small blue glass building located at the CNFK HQ building (grey castle).
- No currency exchange.
- Only pull out KRW or USD.

Smoking on Base

- Smoking is prohibited while walking on base.
- You must stop and smoke or find a designated smoking area.
