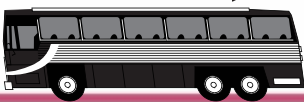

## ★Doll's Festival at Tomisaki Shrine & Katsuura Undersea Park | Sun, Mar 1

Celebrate Hinamatsuri at the breathtaking Tomisaki Shrine, the crown jewel of Katsuura City's annual Doll Festival. Marvel at approximately 1,800 exquisite Hina dolls adorning the shrine's 60 stone steps in a spectacular tiered display that captures the essence of this cherished Japanese tradition.

Next, dive into an underwater adventure at Katsuura Undersea Park's marine observatory. Standing 24 meters above the waves and descending 8 meters below the surface, this remarkable structure takes you into an aquatic wonderland where you'll observe fascinating sea creatures and the mysterious ocean floor.

If rain cancels the festival, we'll visit Kamogawa Sea World instead.
