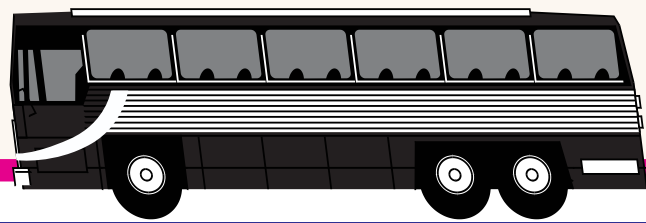

★Fujido Cave, Sky Bridge & Daruma Temple | Sat, Jul 12

Experience the Fujido Limestone Cave, which is about 2.2 kilometers deep and is one of the largest in the Kanto Plain. Then we will visit the Daruma Temple. This temple was built in 1697 and is also the place where the popular-bearded Japanese Daruma Dolls originated. Daruma Dolls are known as good luck charms. **NOTE: Admission fees are included.**

★Fuji Sightseeing at West Lake Sai | Sun, Jul 13

This tour begins with Fuji Fugaku Windcave and Narusawa Hyoketsu Ice Cave followed by a visit to Saiko Iyashi-no-Sato Nenba, which is a village with traditional thatched-roof houses situated on the shore of Lake Sai with Mt. Fuji as the backdrop. Lastly, this tour will conclude with a visit to Lake Kawaguchi.

NOTE: Due to age restrictions, you must be at least 5 years old for the Ice Cave.

The famous Mt. Fuji is 3,776 meters (12,389 feet high) and will test your ability to climb in high altitudes to the limit. We will start our hike at Fuji Subaru Line 5th station. Price includes bus transportation, tour guide service, Mt. Fuji Climber Coin & t-shirt. Due to high altitudes and arduous trail conditions this tour is restricted to those 6 years and older. In case of inclement weather, tour will be cancelled. **NOTE: Climbers must complete the Mt. Fuji Safety Brief prior to sign-up. Brief can be accessed online via the MWR Atsugi website's homepage. A ¥1000 donation will be asked at the beginning of the climb. This donation is optional.**

***Advanced:** Trails are 90% up and down hill with rugged and slippery terrain, with a total distance of 6 to 10 miles. Mt. Fuji falls in this category due to its high elevation.

Shirane in Yamanashi Prefecture is one of the few places in the Kanto Plain where peach picking is available. Pick and eat as many peaches as you can in 60 minutes. Additional peaches are available for purchase. Next, we will visit Kanazakura Shrine at Shosenkyo Gorge. Yamanashi is famous for its crystals and the shrine's sacred treasure is a collection of large crystal balls. Afterwards, we will enjoy a leisurely 50-minute walk at Shosenkyo Gorge. **NOTE: Recommend bringing a small towel to wash your hands from handling peaches and rain gear.**
