Let's enjoy cooler temperatures near Mt. Fuji. Our first stop will be Arakurayama Sengen Shrine with about 398 steps and offers the famous view of Mt. Fuji and a five-storied pagoda. Next stop is Fujiyoshida Sengen shrine that marks the trailhead used as the common starting point for climbing Mount Fuji. Next we will go to Mt. Fuji 5th station that is currently the common starting point for climbing with shops and restaurants. Lastly, we will visit Bat Lava Cave which is the largest among the lava caves at the foot of Mt. Fuji.

Note: Sandals are not recommended for the Lava Cave.

In case of inclement weather, tour will be cancelled.

NAF Atsugi MWR ITT Hiking Classification:

- EASY / BEGINNER:** Trails are 80% flat and 20% ascending and descending. Total distance—about 6 miles.
- INTERMEDIATE:** Trails are 50% uphill and downhill, and 50% flat, with a variety of terrain. Ascending these trails are moderately physically demanding and descending them is moderately demanding on lower body muscles and joints. Total distance is 6 to 10 miles.
- ADVANCED:** Trails are 90% up and down hill with rugged and slippery terrain, with a total distance of 6 to 10 miles. Mt. Fuji falls in this category due to its high elevation.
