Mt. Fuji Main Shrine & Minobusan Temple: Sat, Jul 3 (21184a)

Visit Minobusan Kuonji Temple that was founded in 1274 as a sacred site of the Lotus Sutra, where there are paths that go through scenic gardens and numerous historical structures. Next, we'll explore Hongu Sengentaisha Shrine, which among the 1,300 shrines in Japan is the main shrine and center of worship.

Fuji 5 to Summit Climb or Fuji 1-5 Hike: Sat, Jul 31 (21212a)

Ages (6+): \$60 / Blue Jacket Liberty (E1-E5): \$48

Mileage: 300 km

Mt. Fuji is 3770 meters / 12,389 feet high and will test your ability to climb in high altitudes to the limit. You'll start at the Fuji Subaru Line 5th station. Price includes bus transportation, tour guide service, Mt. Fuji Climber Coin & T-shirt. Due to high altitudes and arduous trail conditions, this tour is restricted to those 6 years and older. In the case of inclement weather, tour will be cancelled.
